

**Bylaw**

---

RESIGNATION AND REMOVAL

As River Edge Board of Education board member's, membership shall cease immediately upon the cessation of his/her bona fide residency in the constituent district he/she represents or upon the member's taking the office of mayor or member of the governing body of River Edge Borough.

A member who fails to attend three consecutive regular meetings of the board without good cause may be removed from office on the affirmative vote of a majority of the full board, provided that such action shall have been proposed at the next preceding meeting of the board and provided that notice of such action has been given to the absent member in advance of the meeting for which such action has been proposed.

A member who resigns from the office of board member shall deliver his/her resignation in writing to the board secretary/business administrator. Any such resignation shall take effect upon its formal acceptance by the board of education duly convened.
