

Bylaw

ELECTION AND DUTIES OF THE VICE PRESIDENT

The vice-president shall preside at board meetings in the absence of the president and shall perform such other duties as may be assigned by the board.

When the office of president is vacant, the vice-president shall serve as acting president until a new president is seated.

The vice-president shall be elected at the reorganization meeting of the board. Nominations of the office of vice-president shall not require a second. Once nominations are closed, a verbal roll call vote is taken on each in the order in which they are nominated until one is elected by a majority of those members present. Should the office become vacant between organizational meetings, it shall be filled in the same manner stated above.
